

Village of Clarksville  
Planning Commission Minutes  
May 16, 2013

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Planning Commission was held May 16, 2013 at the Clarksville Village Hall. Chairperson Robert Blocher called the meeting to order at 6:46 p.m.

Planning Commissioners present – Chairperson Robert Blocher , Vice Chairperson Lu Baxter, *ex officio* Robbie Mutschler, Kerry McMillen, and Jordan Burnie. Absent - None.  
Village Clerk Shari Clark, council members Brad Clark and Pat Reser, and Chad Listerman of C&L Trucking were in also in attendance.

The minutes of the April 18, 2013 meeting were read and approved.

The downtown mural project will most likely not occur, due to the cost involved in using art students from Kendall.

Day in the Park 2013 and the Clarksville Recycling Center will be moved off of the future agendas. Bob and Lu will continue to provide updates to the commission as needed.

A sidewalk walking tour was conducted immediately preceding the meeting with Planning Commissioners, Village Council members, C&L Trucking, and interested citizens. Much discussion occurred regarding the Safe Routes to School grant application. Some commissioners have questions the cost effectiveness of applying for a grant versus the Village implementing such projects with Village funds.

Due to feedback from the Safe Routes to School Committee, Planning Commission has revised their recommendations for the grant application. Proposed new sidewalk construction is as follows:

- First St, from High to Cross, along east side of the road
- W Cross St, from First to Second, along south side of the road
- Second St, from Cross to Lind, along east side of the road
- Lind Ave in its entirety, along north side of the road
- W Ferney Ave, from Second to Fourth, along north side of the road

Village Street Commissioner will be contacting Fleis and VanderBrink engineering in regards to these new recommendations. She will provide feedback prior to the next meeting.

The next Planning Commission Meeting will be held June 20, 2013.  
The meeting adjourned at 7:58 p.m.
