Village of Clarksville Council Meeting Minutes May 10, 2021

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Village Council was held May 10, 2021 at the Clarksville Village Hall. President Amy Byers called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

Other council members present – Trustees Patricia Reser, Bonnie Main, Allen Sheldon, Brad Clark, Robin Wahl (virtually), Treasurer Rose Barratt, and Clerk Shari Clark. Absent – Trustee Joseph Graham.

Public Comments were heard regarding drainage issues behind residences on S. First Street. Storm drain camera imaging on file will be studied by village officials, street commissioner Sheldon will continue research and will consult with the county drain commissioner. Motion by B.Clark and supported by Reser to approve up to \$300.00 expenses, if needed, for additional camera imaging be conducted by the county drain commissioner. All in favor, motion passed.

The minutes of the April 5, 2021 meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Sheldon and supported by B.Clark to pay monthly bills totaling \$7,444.26. All in favor, motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Barratt, Street Commissioner Sheldon, Sewer by B.Clark, *ex officio* Planning Commissioner Main, Clerk by S.Clark, and President Byers.

Council authorized small group meetings to resume in the Clarksville Village Hall contingent to a signed agreement that the organization will adhere to current MDHHS standards and keep attendance for tracking purposes in case a participant develops covid. Hall rentals have not yet been approved due to current limits.

As of 5/6/21 MDHHS current guidelines allow non-residential indoor gatherings of up to 25 people, must wear face masks unless eating or drinking while seated in a group of no more than 6 people, and those groups maintain 6 feet distance.

Clarksville Farmer's Market will begin June 12, 2021 Saturdays 9 am – 12 pm.

Motion by Sheldon and supported by B.Clark to accept Manszewski Landscaping \$1,350.00 bid to place & change out seasonal banners & decorations. All in favor, motion passed.

Motion by B.Clark and supported by Main to authorize closure of Main Street 8am – 7pm for the annual Clarksville Ox Roast event to be held Saturday August 14, 2021. All in favor, motion passed.

The Clarksville Memorial Day Parade will be canceled this year due to the Auxiliary VFW Post 4461 not participating because of covid concerns.

The meeting adjourned at 8:35 pm.

The next regular meeting will be held 7 pm June 7, 2021 with a ZBA meeting to immediately follow.
