

Village of Clarksville
Council Meeting Minutes
November 1, 2021

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Village Council was held on November 1, 2021 at the Clarksville Village Hall. President Amy Byers (attending virtually) called the meeting to order at 7pm. All council members present – Trustees Joseph Graham, Patricia Reser, Bonnie Main, Allen Sheldon, Brad Clark, Robin Wahl (virtually), Treasurer Rose Barratt, and Clerk Shari Clark.

Public comments were heard from Lakewood Girl Scout Troop #4632 regarding placing a Little Free Library for their Silver Award within the village. Motion by Sheldon and supported by Main to authorize the Girl Scouts to set a post for a lending library box and place next to the sidewalk near the handicap space located by the southeast corner of Clarksville Village Hall. All in favor, motion passed.

The minutes of the October 4, 2021 meeting were read and approved. Motion by Graham and supported by Reser to pay monthly bills totaling \$9,551.91 plus incoming Consumer Energy bills. All in favor, motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Rose Barratt, Street Commissioner Sheldon, Sewer by B.Clark, *ex officio* Planning Commissioner Main, Clerk by S.Clark, and President Byers.

Motion by Reser and supported by B.Clark to appoint Alexia Hoffman and to re-appoint Joshua Depew to Village Planning Commission. All in favor, motion passed. President Byers appointed each for a 3-year term as Village Planning Commissioner. Hoffman was officially sworn in by the clerk.
