Motion by Graham and supported by B.Clark to accept monthly bills totaling \$7,141.72 plus incoming Consumers bills . All in favor, motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Barratt, Street Commissioner Sheldon, Sewer by B.Clark, ex officio Planning Commissioner Main, Clerk S.Clark, and President Byers.

Motion by Graham and supported by Reser to accept \$26,748.00 bid from Murray's Asphalt Maintenance to resurface Nash Street from Main Street going east to the dead end. Motion passed. Bids for Broad Street are still under consideration with other projects to fit into budget.

Village Planning Commission 2022 Meeting Calendar amended to remove June and August meetings.

Motion by Graham and supported by Winkler to authorize closure of Main Street on August 13, 2022 from 8am – 7pm for the annual Clarksville Ox Roast event.

Motion by Sheldon and supported by Graham to have Village Clerk draft a tax bill enclosure letter to communicate to residents the need for additional Village Planning Commission Members. Motion passed.
