

Village of Clarksville
Council Meeting Minutes
November 7, 2022

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Village Council was held November 7, 2022 at the Village Hall. President Amy Byers called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

Other council members present Trustees Debra Winkler, Allen Sheldon, Bonnie Main, Patricia Reser, Brad Clark, Treasurer Rose Barratt, and Clerk Shari Clark. Absent – Trustee Joseph Graham.

Public comments were heard from village resident Tina Leazier in support of a safe pedestrian route to Dollar General.

The minutes of the October 3, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

A presentation was shared from Deb Aldrich, President of the Lake Odessa Auxiliary VFW Post 4461, explaining their Home Town Heroes project posting Veteran Banners in Lake Odessa. She is encouraging other surrounding communities to seek out volunteers to take on a similar project within each village.

Responses from the Questionnaire re: Safe Route to Dollar General were reviewed with the majority in favor.

Bids for a proposed Main Street Pedestrian Bridge were presented by Jonathan Moxey, Fleis & Vandenbrink Project Manager. Two bids under consideration will be revised and presented at the next meeting.

Motion by Sheldon and supported by B.Clark to pay monthly bills totaling \$23,906.10. Motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Barratt, Street Commissioner Sheldon, Sewer by B.Clark, *ex officio* Planning Commissioner Main, and Playground Committee representative Winkler.

Clarksville Village Planning Commission will host their fourth Annual Tree Lighting Event with special guest appearance from Santa to be held Friday November 25th 4:30-7:30pm next to the village gazebo.

Motion by Winkler and supported by Main to renew updated snow removal contract with CL Trucking & Excavating, LLC. All in favor, motion passed.

Motion by Sheldon and supported by Reser to accept \$2,500.00 annual quote from Manszewski Landscaping for placement & maintenance of seasonal banners and for landscaping around village welcome signs. All in favor, motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 8:43 pm.
