Village of Clarksville Council Meeting Minutes January 9, 2024

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Village Council was held January 9, 2024 at the Clarksville Village Hall. President Amy Byers called the meeting to order at 7pm.

All council members present – Trustees Debra Winkler, Patricia Reser, Bonnie Main, Allen Sheldon, Brad Clark, Scott Briggs, Treasurer Rose Barratt, and Clerk Shari Clark.

No public comment.

The minutes of the December 4, 2023 meeting were read and approved.

Moved by Sheldon and supported by Main to approve monthly bills totaling \$15,752.77. All in favor, motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Barratt, Street Commissioner Sheldon, Sewer by B.Clark, ex officio Planning Commissioner Main, and Clerk S. Clark.

Budget items were discussed. The Annual Budget Hearing will be held February 5, 2024 at 7pm.

Two new catch basins have been installed by CL Trucking & Excavating in alley behind the body shop, as recommended by Street Commissioner Sheldon & Assistant B.Clark for early completion while frost levels were still low, \$5,400.00 estimate was pre-authorized by President Byers.

Street Easement mapping, as recommended by Planning Commission, will be reviewed by council further. Clerk will research best resources to access legal measurement data. The overall goal is to have proper measurements on record to assist in the zoning permit approval process.

Moved by B.Clark and supported by Main to accept \$67,900.00 estimate from Murray's Asphalt Maintenance to mill and resurface Broad Street. All in favor, motion passed. Street Commissioner Sheldon will schedule project in May 2024.

Reminder to residents that it is the responsibility of the property owner to shovel sidewalks and off-street parking is required per ordinance. Sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice (within 24 hours in residential districts & within 4 hours in the business district after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet, or freezing rain) and vehicles may not be parked longer than 12 hours on Main Street or 24 hours on other public streets within the village. For persons within the residential district that this would cause undue hardship, they may file a request for exemption with the Village Clerk.

The meeting adjourned at 7:57 pm.
