Moved by Sheldon and supported by B.Clark to support the 2025 Operating Tax Millage to be levied, to reflect the 2025 Headlee Millage Reduction Fraction 0.9836 reducing the current millage to 8.2127. Motion passed.

Additional roofing estimates for Village Hall will be sought out for review at next meeting.

Moved by B.Clark and supported by Sheldon to accept Simon Inc. \$405.00 estimate to wash the Clarksville Village Hall building. Motion passed.
