

Village of Clarksville
Council Meeting Minutes
July 7, 2025

A regular monthly meeting of the Village Council was held July 7, 2025 at the Clarksville Village Hall.

President Tristen Alderink called the meeting to order at 7pm.

All council members present – Trustees Debra Winkler, Bonnie Main, Brian Reser, Allen Sheldon, Brad Clark, Scott Briggs, Treasurer Rose Barratt, and Clerk Shari Clark.

No public comment.

The minutes of the June 2, 2025 meeting were read and approved.

Moved by Sheldon and supported by B.Clark to pay monthly bills totaling \$43,776.23. All in favor, motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Barratt, Street Commissioner Sheldon, Sewer by B.Clark, *ex officio* Planning Commissioner Main, Clerk S.Clark, President Alderink, and Playground Committee Sheldon & Winkler.

Street sweeping will occur this week and next. Appreciation was expressed to Brad Clark for installing the four new welcome signs. Alderink proposed scheduling a joint meeting to enhance communication between Village Council & Planning Commission members. Winkler will seek out costs for a bench and picnic table for the new playground area.

The Village Council will not be pursuing further legal action against the Hoffman's in the spirit of building a good relationship with the business owners and continuing to help Clarksville grow.

Additional roof estimates for the Village Hall will be sought out.

The Clarksville Ox Roast event provided the requested parameters for use of the R2 Lots south of McCormick on the Hoffman Housing Old School Apartments property, as suggested by the Village Zoning Administrator, to meet public health, safety, and welfare of the community.

The Ox Roast events will be held August 9, 2025 7am-9pm on Main Street between Cross & High Streets, on west Nash St, East High St, 170 McCormick St, vacant R2 Lots south of McCormick west of Main Street, and Campbell Township & Fire Department. Restrooms will be available at the Village Hall, rental units in the village parking lot, and ADA compliant restrooms at Clarksville Bible Church Grace Center. Traffic & Parking – Main Street completely closed for 2 blocks, 2 north/south routes through town remain on First Street & Broad Streets, as previously approved by council. No fireworks are planned. Proposed events to be held on the R2 Lots south of McCormick of the Hoffman Old School Apartment property on the grassy area & ball diamond will be a Car Show 12-3pm and Dodge Bull Tournament following the Ox Roast Dinner during daylight hours only.

Moved by B.Clark and supported by Reser to allow the events as requested on the vacant grass lots south of McCormick during the Ox Roast single day special event. All in favor, motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 8:12pm.

The next regular meeting will be held August 4, 2025.
